



### **Lutheran Campus Ministry Reflections**



Several times this past semester, conversation around the table at dinner with students Thursday night after Evening Prayer Worship turned to our experiences through the pandemic. Students talked about the ways their final year(s) of high school had been upended, how they did college searches entirely online, what it felt like to be masking and distancing here on campus. It seems that we have moved far enough through the crisis of the COVID-19 pandemic to be able to look back, reflect, and share together about it. As we acknowledge loss and grief, we also notice signs of new life.

Of course, we all know that the virus is not gone, yet most campuses and communities are finding ways to navigate the risks, difficulties, and occasional outbreaks. Campus ministry staff and others who work with students talk about the mental health challenges students are facing, trauma informed ministry, and ways to help students move on from the years of crisis and uncertainty.

Ironically, as we hear that young people are not particularly interested in church, I am hearing how much our students appreciate the chance to step away from the demands of college life into a community where they feel seen and safe. The stage is set for authentic community as they pray and sing together, share scripture and reflection, and lift up the concerns they have for themselves, people in their lives, and the wider world. After years of isolation, students seem to be even more deeply drawn to campus ministry, where they can raise questions about God, themselves, or the world; where they can trust that they are welcome just as they are; where they will be encouraged to grow and uncover how they will bless and bring meaning to their own lives and the communities around them.

We are all in the midst of recovering from a wide array of losses, and still God draws us together into community where students find unconditional welcome. In a place where they are truly heard and seen, they will heal, grow, and discover how very loved and gifted they are and that God is always bringing new life.
